**Minimum Hours Required for Degree: 34**

MAE candidates are required to take the Subject Area Praxis Series Exam for their specific area of study prior to graduating from Truman. Each student must score at or above the median score on their respective Subject Area exam in order to be recommended for teacher certification and approved for graduation with the MAE Degree. The median score is a norm-referenced score that may vary slightly from year to year; however, students will be required to score at or above the median that is in effect according to ETS' records for the date the test was taken. If the test for a specific area of study changes and score reports are not produced at the time the test is given, the median score reported at the time the score report is produced will be required.

The Praxis is generally taken the semester when enrolled in MUSI 608G Management of Instruction.

The Praxis test required for the MAE program in Music is *Music: Content Knowledge (with a listening section)*.
